The deadline for abstract submissions is 11:59pm CST October 2nd, 2023. Please send your submissions in a word document to dream@chrim.ca.

Abstracts should be submitted using 12-point font, with a maximum of 300 words, excluding title, authors and affiliations. Abstracts should be broken down into clearly identifiable components of Background/Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions/Importance. The abstracts and posters should clearly state the research findings and should not be open-ended.

All submissions will be asked to do a poster presentation in the format below Dimensions: 90cm width and 60cm length (QR code is optional)

Poster Session Details:

The poster session will be held on Nov. 15th from 4:30-6:30pm at the Fort Garry Hotel. The presentation will be 7 minutes total (5-minute presentation followed by 2 minutes of questions).

Awards:

Financial awards will be given to the top 3 poster presentations.

Travel Assistance:

The top 2 externally submitted abstracts will also receive up to \$1000 to support airfare and accommodations to present the poster and attend the DREAM symposium .
