12th Annual Dream Symposium: Using Team Science to Understand Type 2 Diabetes and its Complications



The DREAM Symposium was held on November 16, and the theme was "Using Team Science to Understand Type 2 Diabetes and its Complications". The symposium began with an opening blessing from Elder Andy Wood which was followed by a performance from Walking Wolf Drum Group. Dr. Denise Feig presented the Heather Dean lecture. Invited guest speakers from across North America flew to Winnipeg to speak about their different research projects.

The DREAM Trainee Day on November 15 focused on professional career development. The day consisted of a cultural safety presentation by Dr. Linda Diffey, a grant-writing seminar presented by Dr. Jon McGavock, and a panel discussion with academic and non-academic panelists, followed by a poster session. Congratulations to Jasmine Pipella and Khushali Trivedi for tying for second place for the trainee poster competition, and Patience Obi for winning first place!



OUTREACH 2024

The **iCARE** and **NextGen team**, along with Dr. Chukwudumebi Onyiuke of the Four Arrows Regional Health Authority's research and data unit, completed an outreach trip to Island Lake Anisininew Nation communities in March with guidance from Tanya McDougall, an Anisininew Nation scholar, and Lionel Mason, an Elder and Knowledge-Sharer. The team screened at-risk participants for diabetes and kidney disease, met with community leadership and hosted two community feasts to share results and build relationships.
